## Financial Aid Disbursement Dates for Summer 2024

Federal Grant is the foundation of Financial Aid for undergraduates who demonstrate need. The Pell Grant offer is based on the Expected Family Contribution, and full-time enrollment status. The Pell Grant disbursement is prorated according to the active units if less than full-time. Summer Pell Grant awards are typically disbursed in one payment during the summer session. Students must maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress to be eligible.

Method of Fund Disbursement: Santa Ana College delivers your refund with BankMobile Disbursements, a technology solution, powered by BMTX, Inc. Students must select their financial aid disbursement method in order to receive their financial aid award funds within the disbursement schedule. Selecting a refund preference can be done by logging in to the student's WebAdvisor, choose your disbursement option (BankMobile Disbursements) by clicking on "Access BankMobile", and follow the instructions to choose the preferred method of disbursement. Students who do not select a refund preference will have their paper check delivered by the USPS after 21 business days from the funding day.

## **Summer 2024 Enrollment and Award:**

If you have received the maximum 100% of your 2023-2024 Pell Grant eligibility, you must enroll in at least half-time (6 units) in Summer 2024 to be eligible for any Pell Grant for the summer 2024 semester using the eligible Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of your 2023-2024 FAFSA.

If you have received the maximum 100% of your 2023-2024 Pell Grant eligibility, and plan to enroll less than half-time (less than 6 units) in summer 2024, you must complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA, have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) eligible for less than half-time enrollment, have your 2024-2025 file completed (no missing documents) and processed to be eligible for any Pell Grant for summer 2024. If this applies to you, contact our Financial Aid Office for more information at (714) 564-6242.

Federal regulations require that students must pay back part or all of their financial aid disbursements if students withdraw from all or part of their classes after receiving their disbursements. If you consider dropping your classes, contact our Financial Aid Analyst for more information.
