

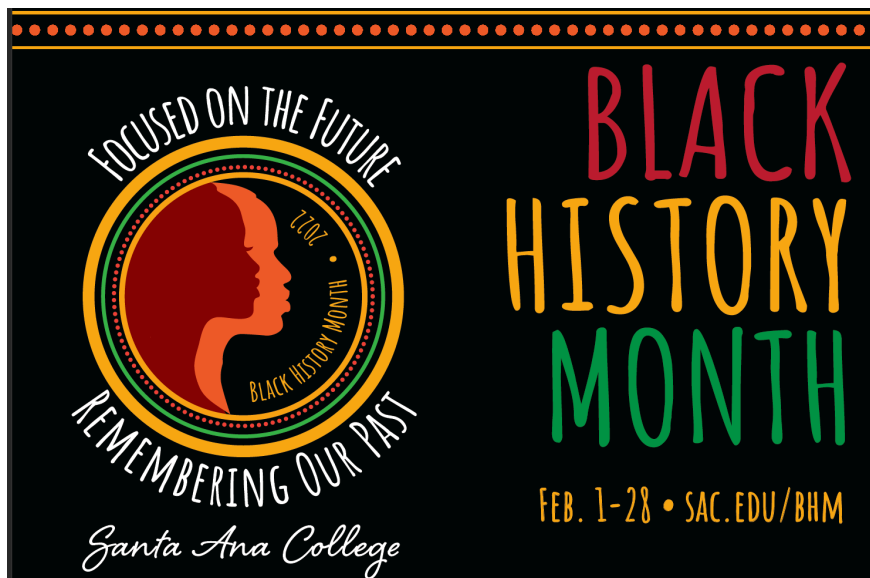

Inspired by the Negro Motorist Green Book — published annually by New York City mailman Victor H.
