- 2. Approval of the <u>minutes from Nov. 29</u> [action]
  - a. Moved by Adam Morgan.

- 3. Public comment: no public comment was made.
- 4. <u>Technology Refresh Plan</u> [action]
  - a. Ron Gonzalves: presented the aging report and forecast.
  - b. The total forecast cost for 2024-2025 for the 5-year computer cycle is \$506,687.
  - c. Louis Pedroza: asked the question: "When the computers are purchased when is the turnaround time for the CPUS to get installed?" The answer was within a year.
  - d. Media Tech Refresh Plan 2024-2025 to modernize A/V equipment for the Phillips Theater.
  - e. Motion to recommend to Planning & Budget Committee that \$1,356,675 in funding beyond the \$500k baseline be allocated to fund the plan in the next fiscal year.

  - b. Information Technology Services
    - i. Windows 11 Ron Gonzalves will be testing the installation for Windows 11 and the Windows 10 OS will end in 2025.

    - i. John Steffens: Two additional knowledge bases are live in the Ocelot chatbot: Student Business Office and Bookstore. Service areas have begun testing Colleague integration.
