Policy Framework

- Rationale: to respond to faculty apprehensions regarding any potential requirement or ban on the use of generative artificial intelligence (GenAI)
- Framework summary
 - The treatment of GenAl falls under faculty purview,
 - The usage of GenAl is an issue of academic freedom,
 - o Faculty have the authority to determine appropriate use,
 - Faculty have a responsibility to communicate
- Recommendation: adapt the policy framework into a resolution to be passed by the senates

Faculty AI Guidelines

- Rationale: to provide faculty with language and suggestions for how to incorporate, or prohibit the use of GenAI in their courses
- Summary
 - o Faculty are responsible for communicating GenAl policy (syllabus language options offered)
 - o Suggests general approaches to support proper attribution, responsible use, and student learning.
- Recommendation: Adapt the guidelines to be posted on the website as a faculty resource. Add links to appropriate related resources (e.g. libguides, professional development, etc.)

Student Al Guidelines

- Rationale: to offer students a reference to know if, and how they can use GenAl on classroom settings
- Summary
 - Usage policy and academic integrity
 - o Attribution and citing recommendations
 - o Documentation and data privacy suggestions
- Recommendation
 - o Adapt the guidelines to be posted on the website as academic support. Add links to appropriate related resources (e.g. libguides)
 - o Use usage policies to update academic integrity language

Standing Committee Recommendation

- Rationale: Usage of GenAI will likely affect more than just classroom policies. Enrollment, assessment, data privacy, and many other issues require dedicated review of existing and upcoming policies and practices that are beyond the scope of this task force.
- Summary of responsibilities
 - Policy development
 - Review GenAl application
 - o Evaluate risks
 - Ensure accountability
- Recommendations
 - o Adapt the committee description into a resolution to be passed by the senate.
