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Department of Human Development

is changing to

Department of Child Development and Education Studies

Rationale:

- Across the state, education classes are within child development departments at community college level, including ours.
 - Bridging Human Development and Education into one single Department Name
 - Current Ed classes: ED100, ED209, ED210, ED211, ED113, ED204, ED205
- Field has continued to evolve:
 - More reflection of “education” in addition to “development” of young children
 - 31 departments statewide have made this name change to reflect the inclusion of education
- Need a clear department and degree/certificate name to match our department goals and outcomes
 - We do not teach all human development (e.g., gerontology)
 - We do focus on infancy through adolescence (hence, child development instead of human development)
 - Our department has a transfer education degree
 - Our department is about to hire an Assistant Professor whose expertise is in the field of education (in past, focus is on early childhood/child development)

- Speech Pathology (HD107 and HD108A)
- Certificate in Social Services (HD107, HD110, HD205)
- General Education (HD107 and HD110)
