VI. CIC Chair's Report

A. META - MAVERICK

Creating a New vs. Revised Course Proposal

D. Peraza demonstrated the difference between the process of creating a new course or program in currlQunet modifying an existing one.

VII. Discussion

D. Peraza proposed using the Chancellor's Office Curriculum Inventory (COCI) CCN Supplemental Worksheet to capture all Part 2 information for any CCN course, instead of entering it directly into currlQunet. He explained that once the worksheet is completed, it would be uploaded as a supplemental document when submitting CCN courses in COCI. This supplemental information would then be automatically populated by the Tech Center in COCI once the templated is created with Part 2.

Discussion followed.

P. Canzona voiced concerns about not entering Part 2 information directly into the Course Outline of Record (COR) in currlQunet. She emphasized that when submitting for university articulation, all necessary information must be included in the COR.

VIII. Announcements

A. Developing a Freely Available, Sustainable, and Transferable (FAST) AI Program – A Professional Development Grant in Collaboration with UCI

M. Dinh-Mahavongtrakul mentioned that she applied for the FAST grant, which, if awarded to SAC, would fund Professional Development (PD) aimed at educating faculty on using Artificial Intelligence (IA) to enhance student learning and reduce faculty anxiety.

B. Common Course Numbering – Phase II

D. Peraza announced the launch of Common Course Numbering (CCN) Phase II and emphasized the importance of feedback on the surveys. He noted that templates for Phase II will soon be developed and encouraged any interested faculty members to submit their nominations to the Academic Senate. He further stated that faculty selected to participate in a discipline workgroup would receive compensation.
