 - a. 2019-2020 Equity Allocation Requests – Dr. Lamb
 - i. Forms have been updated and revised in order to connect forms to Integrated Plan/Guided Pathways.

- a. Kathy – Some of the questions felt repetitive (describing the project description and the outcomes several times).
 - i. Dr. Lamb - Will look into revising some of the questions into a bigger picture answer.
 - b. Maria Aguilar Beltran –#2 and #6 were very similar.
 - i. Dr. Lamb – #2 was framed more of intended outcome/goal, #6 was specifically linking it to program/department, course, and/or institutional level outcome review.
 - c. Justin – #5 wasn’t tied to the rubric.
 - i. Dr. Lamb – would be good for the group who is looking to see when the money is spent out during the fiscal year.

 - i. Shared Governance Structure – Dr. Hubbard and Dr. Janio
 - 1. Dr. Hubbard – updated draft includes the changes that were recommended in the last Student Success and Equity meeting.
 - a. Dr. Lamb – still needs to go for approval to College Council, Cabinet, Academic Senate. Dr. Lamb would like to still have meetings occur between co-chairs in order to discuss agenda and funding.

 - ii. Evaluating the Allocation Process and Linking it to the Plan – Dr. Lamb

College Council has approved the reinstating of the Institutional Effectiveness Committee in order to look at Program Review, this will be a good way to connect the Equity Planning process to Institutional Effectiveness.

 - a. Our disproportionately impacted group is white males without economic challenges (impacted by the Academies). Data is finalized, we are behind based on our timeline, but have been impacted by the Chancellor’s Office data changing.
