a. Maria Aguilar Beltran began the meeting at 3:05 pm. Welcomed the committee and followed with minute approval

#### **II.** Action Items:

- a. Approval of Minutes from December 3, 2020
  - i. Maria Aguilar Beltran requested a motion to approve December 3, 2020 minutes.

# IV. Group Updates (Task Force or Workgroups)

- a. Integrated Equity Plan Update Maria Aguilar Beltran
  - i. Maria Aguilar Beltran shared that the Integrated Equity Plan is currently being updated to follow the Chancellor's Call to Action. Looking into updating the realities of systemic racism and how we can update the policies that can potentially be creating more barriers.
  - ii. Dr. Hubbard: Agreed that policies should be revised to ensure they make sense for our students now and not be the same policies enforced from when SAC opened.

- iii. Dr. Merari Weber: Old policies can lead to old habits and it is important to look into updating them
- b. Men of Color Update Dr. Armando Soto
  - i. Dr. Armando Soto shared details from the January 26th meeting attended by Dr. Marty Romero, Leo Pastrana and Dr. Fernando Ortiz. Their conversation focused on their personal experiences and the experience of students as far as policy standpoint and COVID realities. Men of Color goals are to explore the data that shows Men of Color not preforming and understand what the male experience is on campus. Engage Men of Color in community services and look into how to connect them to service learning and the larger community. Work on creating environments to produce changes Men of Color need.
  - ii. Plan is to continue dialogue and partner with Learning & Engagement to look at data of younger males in correlation with development, need to work and specific life experiences. Agreed on a need of an equity center to build community, workshops/guest speakers to reflect on their own experience. Looking to recruit more Men of Color to the group
  - iii. Dr. Merari Weber suggested a inviting non-credit men of color (amended)
  - iv. Geoff Jones shared that the thing in common with most of his football players was the refusal to ask for help. Agreed that a center to communicate and ask questions is a great idea. Proposed an idea of an advisor program
  - v. Suggestion to invite Kalonji Satterfield, John Nguyen, Alondo Campbell, Chris Sanchez (amended)
- c. Other Groups-Maria Aguilar Beltran
  - i. Maria Aguilar Beltran shared that conversations are in the works on how the SEAP committee can successfully tackle the projects and issues that are discussed in the form of task forces or workgroups and only meet as a SEAP committee once every other month

- b. Professional Development Amberly Chamberlain
  - Amberly Chamberlain shared templates to show 2021 virtual Spring
    Convocation attendance and attendee comments. Received lots of positive
    feedback. Will be sharing a comparison of attendance from 2019-2021 and
    what could be potential factors of differences including breakout sessions.

- c. Guided Pathways Stephanie Clark
  - i. Stephanie Clark shared that Success Teams are currently focusing on Ed Plans, correct majors and career exploration events. Spring teams will be
