The following action taken at the Pharmacy Technician Accreditation Commission meeting on October 22, 2025:

VOTED

To approve for reaccreditation the pharmacy technician education and training program at Santa Ana College, Santa Ana, California; further,

To grant accreditation for six years (2031); a midterm progress report will be requested in three years.

(Note: The Commission identified that areas of partial compliance 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, and 9 have been resolved to its satisfaction and no further information needs to be provided in these areas on the midterm progress report; all other areas of partial compliance should be addressed.)

The Commission arrived at its decision based on a thorough review of the report of the survey conducted on March 28, 2025, and your facility's response to the survey findings. The ASHP and ACPE Board of Directors reviewed and accepted the Pharmacy Technician Accreditation Commission on January 22, 2026 and January 28, 2026. This pharmacy technician education and training program has been duly accredited by ASHP/ACPE since March 30, 1984. Accreditation is granted subject to the provisions set forth in the ASHP/ACPE Regulations on Accreditation of Pharmacy Technician Education and Training Programs.
