Nearly 1 in 4 students have struggled to afford period products in the United States. 44% of teens report stress and embarrassment due to a lack of access to period products ([The Widespread impact of period poverty on US Students](#) commissioned by Thinx & PERIOD. October 2023). Over one in three (37%) American adults who menstruate say they or their family have struggled to afford menstrual products ([Crampus Campaign Survey Results](#) by YouGov. November 2023).
