Who?

The CCPRO Writing Scholarship is an annual scholarship program for community college students offered by the Community College Public Relations Organization.

What?

The \$500 CCPRO Writing Scholarship program is designed to encourage students to get published. The scholarship will be awarded to a full-time California community college student who writes a compelling news story, pitches the story to their college newspaper or online publication, and gets published. If the applicant's college does not have a student publication/newspaper, the applicant can write a press release for their college's public information office.

When?

Articles must be published between July 1, 2023 and March 11, 2024.

How?

1. Community college students are asked to write, pitch, and publish an article in their college newspaper or online publication. If the applicant's college does not have a student publication/newspaper, the applicant can write a press release for their college's public information office.
2. Students must scan the completed application and scan or link to the published story (with date/source). Email all materials by **Monday, March 11, 2024** to Cherie Colin at colinc@smccd.edu.
3. The winner(s) will be announced April 10-12, 2024 at CCPRO's annual conference. **The winner(s) will be required to submit a short thank you video.**
