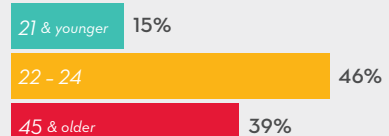

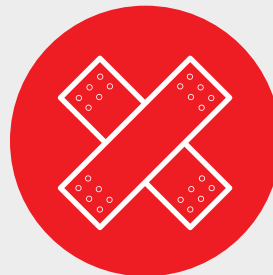

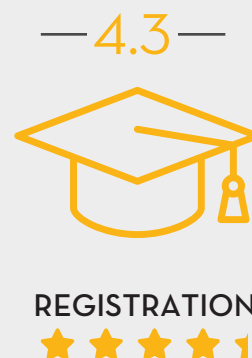

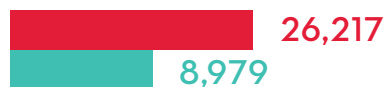

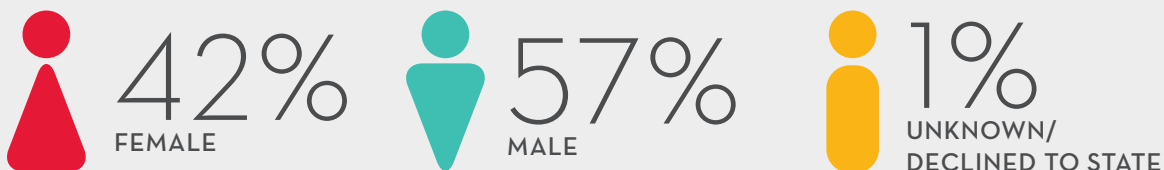

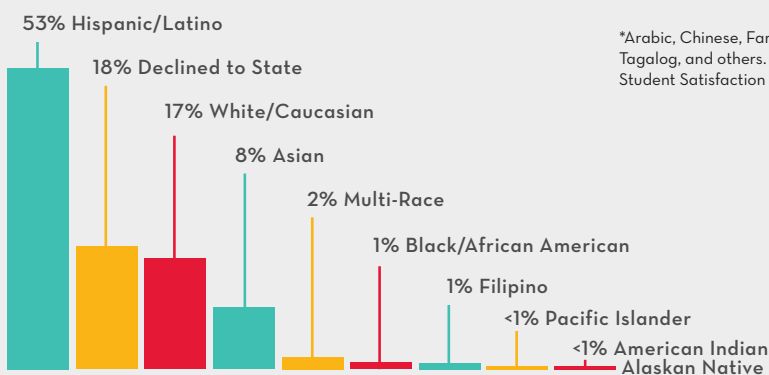
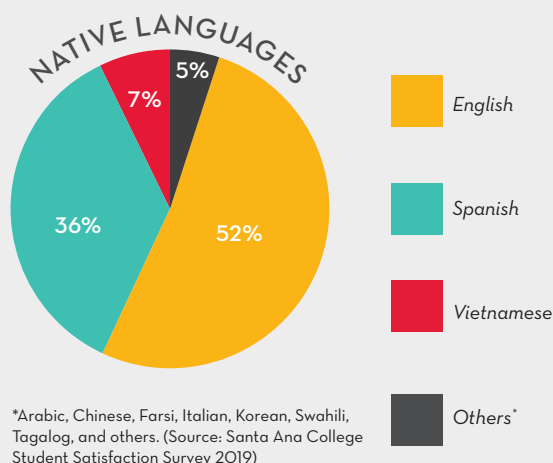
## DISTRIBUTION



AVERAGE AGE = 31



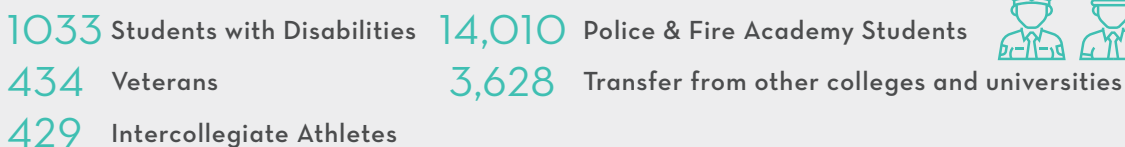
AGE DISTRIBUTION



RACE/ETHNICITY DISTRIBUTION

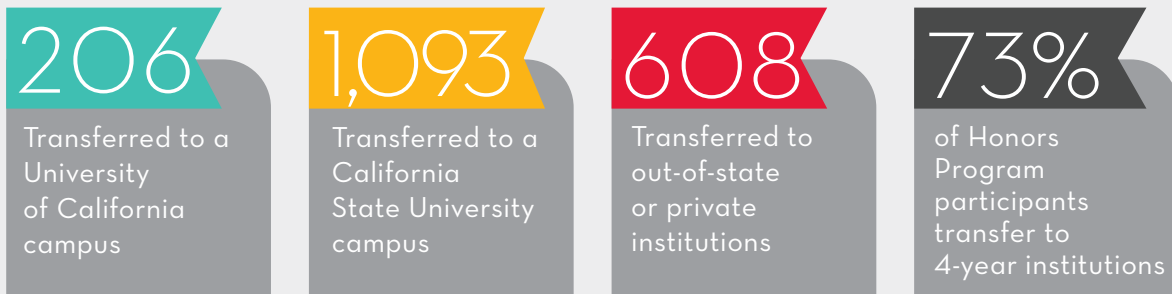
