High School Status Discrepancy—(FAFSA Shows Diploma)

We have found a discrepancy with the information you submitted on your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) vs. what resides with Santa Ana College’s Admissions & Records office.

In order to correct this, you must mark and do one of the following:

- If your Admissions and Records information is correct for either a or c, please correct your FAFSA to reflect the information listed on your Admissions and Records application. (There is no need to turn in this form as the corrections will be automatically transmitted to Financial Aid.)
- If you passed the CHSPE *and* you were home schooled, please correct your FAFSA* to show you were home schooled. (There is no need to turn in this form as the corrections will be automatically transmitted to Financial Aid.)
- If you passed the CHSPE *and* you were not home schooled, please sign below and upload this form with a proof of passage of the CHSPE to your self-service portal.
- If your FAFSA is correct, please email a copy of your diploma along with this form to admissions@sac.edu, so Admissions can update your file. After Admissions and Records has signed this form, please upload it to your self-service portal.

**If you correct your FAFSA and you are required to turn in additional documents, you must wait one week until we can confirm that the correction came through before we can accept your documents.*

**Please note that if you do not have a high school diploma or the equivalent, and you did not complete at least six (6) units of college degree applicable work prior to July 1, 2012, you are not eligible for Federal Financial Aid. You may still be eligible for the California College Promise Grant.
