ELIGIBILITY

The SAC Foundation President's Scholars Program seeks dynamic students who represent high achievements in academics and leadership qualities. In order to be eligible, you must have:

- Minimum GPA of 3.5* while enrolled in 12 units or more, each semester.
- Completed no more than 18 units at SAC as a full-time student.
- Must sign a pledge to complete all transferable units within 2 years of enrollment in the program.
- Application: Personal statement and two letters of recommendation.

SCHOLARS' BENEFITS

- Up to \$5,000 on transfer to a 4 year institution.
- \$1,000 per year renewable textbook stipend upon entering the Program.
- Exclusive access to the College President's roundtable, SACF Board of Directors, and industry experts.
- Underwrite up to 50% of registration and application fees for the Honors Program and Honors Societies. Includes Phi Theta Keppa, Alpha Gamma Sigma, or any other Honor society of your choice.
- Financial literacy training and soft skills training upon transfer.
